



## What do kids think about climate change?

### Kids using their drawings and taglines will soon tell the world

Climate change does not only impact our life today but also jeopardizes the development of next generations. **Kids and young adults born after 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2001 are welcomed to voice their concerns.**

Resources & Synergies Development is a growing community including local small-scale enterprises and one non for profit organization. Our teams work in the scope of efficient utilization natural resources. We are contributing to global awareness and tree planting through a trail gathering 1000 runners in Belgium (19<sup>th</sup> August 2017). We wish to give kids from all over the world a chance to express their views. We are gathering taglines and drawings from 10 000 young people from over one hundred countries. One thousand taglines and one thousand drawings will be carried by the runners during the climate trail in August 2017. The drawing will be printed on the front side of their T-shirt, The tagline will be printed on the back of their T-shirt. Runners will run a distance of 42 km with your drawings and taglines.

On this occasion, we will plant 100 000 trees in the Democratic Republic of Congo (Africa).

If you are born after 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2001, i.e. you are the first generation of the millennium you are kindly invited to participate in the following contest:

1. Write a tagline about climate change (what it means to you)  
**AND / OR**
2. Draw a picture translating your feeling and message about climate change (what it means to you)

#### Rules:

- 1) Only one tagline and one drawing per person; participants may choose to send a tagline only, or drawing only or both a tagline AND a drawing.
- 2) Please give the name of the school, the town or city, the country; in addition the first name of the kid and her or his birth date. The kid will sign his / her drawing or tagline.
- 3) The tagline must include no more than nine words. You may write it in the language of your choice.
- 4) The drawing (inside a rectangle frame) must respect the following dimensions: small side: between 120 mm and 148 mm; big side: 180 mm and 210 mm. Scan the drawing and save it in a file of one of the following formats: pdf, bmp, png ou jpeg. The size of individual files containing one drawing must not exceed 4 Mo.
- 5) Kids must not contact us directly. They participate through their teachers or school masters.

If you wish the pupils and students from your school to participate:

- 1) Register the school on our web site (see below).
- 2) Send us your drawings (scan) or your taglines (e-mail) before 18<sup>th</sup> of June 2017.

The top one hundred drawings and most inspiring taglines shall be rewarded.
